## TRANSPORTATION

## CHECK-IN

### **SUNDAY NIGHT ORIENTATION – 7:00 PM**

Orientation will cover the do's and don'ts of living on a university campus and introduce workshop faculty and staff. It will be directly followed by an orientation meeting with Resident Advisors (for students only).

### **COMMUTERS**

*Commuters are encouraged, but not required, to attend the Sunday night orientation and 7:00 pm in the residence hall.*

Commuters should arrive by 9:00 a.m. daily at the Berg Gallery located at the bottom of the stair court in the Architecture Building (building 5) unless otherwise directed. If commuters are not driving themselves, commuters should be picked up each day, typically around 4:30 pm, except on Tuesdays with pick-up around 9pm. Additionally, there are academic and social activities planned on the weekends. Commuters are expected to attend the academic exercises on Saturdays, and are encouraged to join residential students for the social activities on Sundays.
