



## **PARKING (check-in / check-out / commuters)**

**Permits are required every day, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Parking is strictly enforced on campus.**

**\*\*If you plan to stay longer than 1 hour, please park in Grand Structure 130. Grand Structure 131 is for short-term/drop-off parking only (1 hour or less).\*\***

There is a parking kiosk located in front of the Performing Arts Center, and your vehicle license plate will be required to purchase a permit.

During the week one-day permits are available from dispensers located at each campus entrance and in many general parking lots. The campus map designates dispenser locations. This permit allows you to park in any general or residential lot. Do not park in staff spaces, loading/unloading spaces, sponsored guest spaces or designated event lots with this permit. Metered spaces are also located in lots throughout campus and are indicated on the campus map.

#### **COMMUTERS**

#### **RESIDENT CAMPERS**

*The use of your car is not allowed during the workshop, and is strictly enforced.* If students have their own car, we ask that students give their car keys to one of the head RA's for safe keeping. As students are not allowed off campus on their own, there is no need for a student to have their own car during the workshop. All off-campus transportation will be provided for organized activities during the program.

\*If a resident camper drives themselves to the workshop they must arrange for a parking
